

Student Evaluation of Instruction Faculty Senate Report February 16, 2022

- 1. SEI Committee Membership is complete with a representative from each college. Committee membership also includes a representative from University College, the Library, and three standing members from the Office of Academic Affairs (Dr. McKinney, the previous and current data analysts for the SEIs are standing members)
- **2.** The committee met on Monday, February 14, 2022. Meeting Goals were two-fold: 1)Provide members with updates and, 2) set initial goals for 2022-2023
- SEI Committee Responsibilities were reviewed as posted on Academic Affairs website (*Not necessary to read during Faculty Senate meeting*)

The purpose of the Student Evaluation of Instruction Committee is to supply effective, efficient, and significant means for the periodic evaluation of instruction by the students at the university. Primarily, the committee is concerned with the review and revision, when necessary, of the evaluation form, but can make recommendations for changes in the mechanism of the student evaluation such as who should review the evaluation, when they should be done, etc. Reports directly to the Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs or appointed Vice President for Academic Affairs. This committee is slated by the Committee on Committees of the Faculty Senate. Must hold a faculty position to serve. (337) 482-6454

Charge: Review and revise, the evaluation form, in addition the committee should pilot college specific questions and develop initiatives to increase student response rates.

As a preliminary reflection on the responsibilities of work of the committee going forward, the SEI Committee
Chairperson proposed considering changing the name of the committee from Student Evaluation of Instruction
Committee to Student Feedback on Instruction Committee. The survey would then be called Student Feedback on
Instruction.

Rationale for changing the name included clarity in communicating the difference in two important concepts in the context of teaching and learning: *feedback* and *evaluation*.

- The survey has two components called: *About the Course* and *About the Instructor*
- b) Recent Questions received by Committee Chair and Dr. McKinneys' office were reviewed. There were 6. They surface periodically.

- Can faculty make the completion of the SEI a class assignment and/or an extra credit piece to their class?
- ➤ Can faculty require students to show proof they completed the SEI by submitting the confirmation that it was done?
- ➤ Can faculty assign a grade for completion of the evaluations?
- ➤ Should class time be given?
- > Can university and department averages be shared along with college average?
- ➤ Do students who drop a course receive the survey?

Planning: Establish SEI Ad Hoc Committees

- o Research—Committee members volunteer
 - > Conduct Literature Review (Pros and cons, response rates, major concerns, other themes)
 - ➤ Describe what are other universities doing? What are successes?
 - Recommend what we can we do differently to improve based on findings?
- o Faculty Questions and Concerns—Committee members volunteer
 - ➤ Identify Purpose of Committee
 - Recommend process for gathering concerns and ways to address/respond to concerns
 - Determine how Ad hoc committee work will be organized (leader, goals, meetings, other)

3. Next Steps

- o Define a Process for Reviewing and Making Recommendations to Dr. McKinney
- o Determine Implementation timeline for piloting changes in survey instrument
- o Disseminate AdHoc committee work to SEI Committee
