

Student Evaluation of Instruction Report

The Spring 2016 Student Evaluation of Instruction (SEI) opens to students today, Wednesday, April 20. SEIs will close on Sunday, May 1.

Faculty received an email earlier today, April 20, from Ellen Cook, Assistant VP for Academic Affairs and Academic Resources, with details regarding the process. Her email states that students will receive emails containing a link to their online course evaluations; the survey links can also be accessed on students' Moodle homepage. Reminders will be sent to students encouraging them to complete the evaluations. Students can complete evaluations on smartphones, tablets, and laptops.

The SEI Committee will meet on Monday, April 25, 2016.

The focus of the agenda for April 25 includes:

- reviewing the Distance Learning Taskforce Recommended Revisions for the SEI currently used for online courses including hybrid courses.
- reviewing the current SEI survey used for courses which meet only face to face and discuss ways to improve student usability and greater percentage of return.
- Analyzing data from the faculty responses to survey questions sent out with FALL 15 SEIs this semester (Spring 16).
