



Student Evaluation of Instruction Committee

Faculty Senate Report

April 27, 2022

The SEI Committee met on April 7, 2022.

The primary goal of the meeting was to follow up on several items presented at the previous meeting on February 14, 2022.

SEI Data Analyst Report – Debra Broussard

SEI surveys opened on April 20 and will close at midnight on Sunday, May 1, the night before the first day of final exams week.

There were no SEI issues or concerns reported to the Data Analyst Office between the February and April meetings.

Research Committee Report – Jennifer Hamilton

A preliminary literature review related to Student Evaluation of Instruction was presented by librarian, Jennifer Hamilton. It is noted that so far, a flurry of pandemic-practice informed reports of new methods, research, and recommendations regarding student evaluation of instruction (SEI) is not yet evident. The scope was broadened from 3 to 10 years. Results of this preliminary search is available at [SEI Research Update - April 2022.docx](#)

The Research sub-committee will continue the review of the literature and provide its findings to the committee. Other members of the committee are encouraged to send articles to Jennifer to be included in the report. Pertinent information gleaned from the literature review will be included in SEI committee discussions and reports

Survey Name Change: The Committee agreed to move forward with a proposal to the Vice President of Academic Affairs that the name of the instrument be changed from Student Evaluation of Instruction to Student Feedback on Instruction. The name change more appropriately reflects the purpose of the survey which is to gather feedback on teaching and learning in all courses.

If approved, the Committee recommends the name change goes into effect Summer 2022.

- Determine Implementation timeline for piloting changes in survey instrument
